# Subject: Amendments (07-23) to the International Maritime Solid Bulk Cargoes Code

The International Maritime Organization adopted amendments to the IMSBC Code (07-23) through resolution MSC.539(107). The amendments will enter into force on **1 January 2025** and may be implemented on a voluntary basis from **1 January 2024**. This document intends to bring the essential points of the amendments (07-23) to the attention of all concerned parties, including all shipowners/operators, involved in the operation of ships subject to the IMSBC Code.

### 1. Changes to solid bulk cargoes

The amendments (07-23) newly add and delete solid bulk cargoes in the IMSBC Code Appendix 1 "Individual schedule of solid bulk cargoes", as listed in the following table:

The "Deleted" cargo may be removed from existing IMSBC certificates<sup>1</sup> at the early request of shipowners/operator on or after **1 January 2024**, or should be eliminated at the time of periodical Safety Equipment (SE) survey on or after **1 January 2025**. Where shipowners/operators intend to transport the "New" cargoes by their fleet from **1 January 2024**, they need to apply KR for the addition of such cargoes in IMSBC certificates and, where necessary, for related technical review.

### 1.1 Consequence to other certificates

If the "Deleted" cargo "FISH MEAL (FISH SCRAP), STABILIZED UN 2216 Anti-oxidant treated" as per the amendments (07-23) is listed in the Appendix 2 – List of Individual Cargoes in Bulk of CDG certificate<sup>2</sup>, the cargo should be removed from the list and then the CDG certificate should be re-issued.

Subsequent to the amendments (07-23), MSC.1/Circ.1395/Rev.6 was issued incorporating the addition of related solid bulk cargoes. Among the "New" solid bulk cargoes, the following cargo was included in Table 1 of Annex to MSC.1/Circ.1395/Rev.6, for which a fixed gas fire-extinguishing system may be exempted.

Therefore, where shipowners/operators intend to include the cargo mentioned above in the IMSBC certificates, SOLAS Exemption Certificates for FFEA<sup>3</sup> as per SOLAS regulation II-2/10.7.1.4, if issued, should be also re-issued, as appropriate.

#### 2. Actions requested of concerned parties

Where relevant or necessary, **shipowners/operators** may request KR to re-issue the IMSBC certificates (together with any related certificates, if any<sup>4</sup>) of their fleet for the **deletion** and/or **addition** of the cargoes listed in paragraph 1 above, by requesting technical review <sup>5</sup> and/or by submitting related survey application<sup>6</sup>, from **1 January 2024**.

In case of ships having listed the "Deleted" cargo identified in paragraph 1 in their IMSBC certificates, attending KR surveyors are asked to confirm shipboard IMSBC certificates, remove the "Deleted" cargo above and re-issue them in consultation with shipowners/operators on or after 1 January 2025 but not later than the first periodical Safety Equipment (SE) survey thereafter.
