# ■ Major Amendments

#### O Reason for Amendments

- 1. The existing rule provides requirements for an emergency stopping device for fuel oil pumps outside of the installed area, but it can waive the device for the small capacity of fuel oil pumps.
- 2. The requirements are taken into account that there is no definition of a small capacity pump, and no exemption in Part 5 of the Rules and Guidance for the Classification of Steel Ships.

### O Amendments

1. Delete the waive provision for small capacity fuel oil pumps in 1302 of Chapter 20 Section 13 on Rules for the Classification of Steel Barges.

### O Impact Analysis
