○ Reason for Amendments

1. MSC.1/Circ.1621 "INTERIM GUIDELINES FOR THE SAFETY OF SHIPS USING METHYL/ETHYL ALCOHOL AS FUEL" reflected to the requirements for methyl/ethyl alcohol fueled ships.

○ Amendments

1. The requirements of MSC.1/Circ.1621 is reflected in the Annex 5 of Guidances for the Classification of Ships Using Low-flashpoint Fuels.
