


Sample screen of author warning






Open KR e-Cert. → Signature Panel → Certificate Details → Trust → Add to Trusted Certificates



If PDF is opened on a viewer other than Adobe Reader, the Signature panel may not be visible. You can confirm whether current viewer is PDF reader through the viewer information.








If PDF is not opened by Adobe Reader, you can changing default program for PDF file

2. Defaults apps > Choose default apps by file type






