 In accordance with the following view of IACS, Oil Tankers carrying oil in independent tanks not part of ship's hull such as Asphalt carriers do not fall within the scope of the application of the ESP code. Therefore it's definition of ESP has been revised.

\bigcirc Amendments

- 1. The following requirements are to be added in the definition of ESP
 - : In addition, the related programme applies only to ships having integral tanks in the cargo area. And the Owner in cooperation with the Society is to work out a specific survey programme prior to the commencement of related surveys. Additionally ships subject to the Korean Ship Safety Act is to be also complied with the requirements of Pt 1, Ch 2, 1901.
