# **Establishment of Guidance for Prevention** System of Pollution from Ships

## Related Rules/Guidance

Guidance for Prevention System - ships contracted for construction on or after 1 July 2021

#### ○ Reason for Amendments

- Owing to reinforcement of the Conventions for environmental protection, a specific guidance has been established to manage the requirements on equipment for prevention system of pollution.

### Amendments

- The annex 1-15 (Requirements for CLEAN Notation) and the guidance for Exhaust gas Emission Abatement System have been combined in a guidance for Prevention System of Pollution from Ships.
- The required submission of Certificate or Statement of Compliance in CLEAN2 notation is moved to apply for CLEAN1 notation.
- EEAS notation has been divided to CEmN and CEmS notations for clearer classification.

## Impact Analysis
